


What the U.S. Department of Commerce numbers say

- In 2024, The U.S. merchandise trade deficit with Canada was US\$ 62.0 billion (B) and entirely driven by energy products.
 - Trade in energy represents a U.S. trade deficit of US\$ 96.4B in 2024.
 - Excluding energy, the U.S. has had a merchandise trade surplus with Canada since 2007 and standing at US\$ 34.4B in 2024.
- In contrast, the U.S. has had a surplus for manufacturing since 2007, standing at USS 35.8B in 2024.
- Canada was the only top 5 trade partner with whom the U.S. ran a trade surplus in manufacturing.
- ▶ Canadian natural resources fuel American manufacturing of products stamped "Made in the USA" by American workers.
- The U.S. has had a services trade surplus with Canada for more than the last two decades. This surplus stood at US\$ 33.2B in 2024.

Key takeaways

- In 2024, the U.S. trade deficit with Canada (US\$ 62.0B) was significantly smaller than those with China (US\$ 295.5B) and Mexico (US\$ 171.5B).
- ▶ The U.S.-Canada trade deficit was balanced by an important surplus in foreign direct investment (US\$ 298.0B) in 2023; Canada's investment in the U. S. (US\$ 749.6B) significantly exceeded U.S. investment in Canada (US\$ 451.6B).
- ▶ Canada-U.S. trade makes U.S. industry stronger and more globally competitive. Canada sells inputs to the U.S. that it turns into higher-valued "Made in the USA" goods to export abroad. The U.S. does not give anything for free by trading with Canada.

Canada - U.S. Trade Facts


- Around US\$ 2.5 billion worth of goods and services crosses the Can-U.S. border each day.
- Canada and the U.S traded almost US\$1trillion in goods & services in 2024, representing 12.4% of total U.S. trade.
- ▶ 8 million U.S. jobs are tied to trade with Canada.
- The U.S. sells more to Canada than to any other country.
